

Accreditation	<ul> <li>Junior Main Draw accreditation will be available for collection from Thursday 18 January 2018</li> <li>Junior Main Draw accreditation passes are valid from Thursday 18 – Monday 29 January 2018</li> <li>On arrival at Melbourne Park, all players, coaches and guest are required to visit the Player Accreditation office to collect their Accreditation pass.</li> <li>All Junior players must be present to sign the Junior Player Registration form before nominated guests and coaches can receive their accreditation passes.</li> <li>Players may pre-nominate via the online registration form prior to arriving onsite</li> <li>Each Junior Main Draw Player is entitled to nominate the following individuals for accreditation:         <ul> <li>Two (2) Guests, OR</li> <li>One (1) Guest, and One (1) Personal Coach (must be approved by Junior Tournament Director)</li> </ul> </li> <li>Further, one (1) pre-approved National Federation Coach may receive accreditation per National Boy's/Girl's team.</li> </ul>

Approval for the issue of daily allowance cheques will be given upon presentation of the paid hotel account to the Tournament Director</li> <li>A shuttle service will operate between the AO Juniors hotel (Bayview on the Park) and Melbourne Park. A timetable of shuttle times, commencing from Friday 19 January 2018 will be provided at the Tournament Office in the hotel reception and on aojunior.net</li> <li>Outside the hours of the shuttle service and from Friday 19 January 2018, courtesy cars may be available to AO Junior players depending on availability</li> <li>National Federation Coaches are permitted to book one Airport return transfer per team.
